Overview

Woodland Parent Nursery School (WPNS) has been an important part of the Woodland education system since 1956. We offer play-based education to children ages 2-6 and



emphasize parents' learning alongside their children. Our services are available to the community at low-to-no cost, providing early childhood education to all income levels. Our blended age program builds social development in children, and our family education program builds better parents. Our little school has successful alumni all over the Woodland community – we have educated up to four generations in some families!

Goal

We are seeking donations to update and enhance our educational facility, located in a historic Woodland home. Our **budget is \$100,000 for the facility revitalization**, which will begin construction in Summer 2025. School leadership has worked with our families and children to design an updated facility that will be beautiful and functional.

Rationale

Generations of families have enjoyed this home for nearly 70 years, and it is time to update the facility to match our education needs. Our "Big Vision" includes a redesign of our backyard, as well as critical elements of the historic home. Woodland children deserve a preschool facility that is affordable, flexible, and supportive of their development.





A facility update will allow WPNS to remain a strong option for local families for generations to come without requiring a substantial tuition increase.

Our amazing families will host a farm-to-table groundbreaking event in September 2025. Enhanced access from back of the house to bathrooms and indoor / outdoor room.



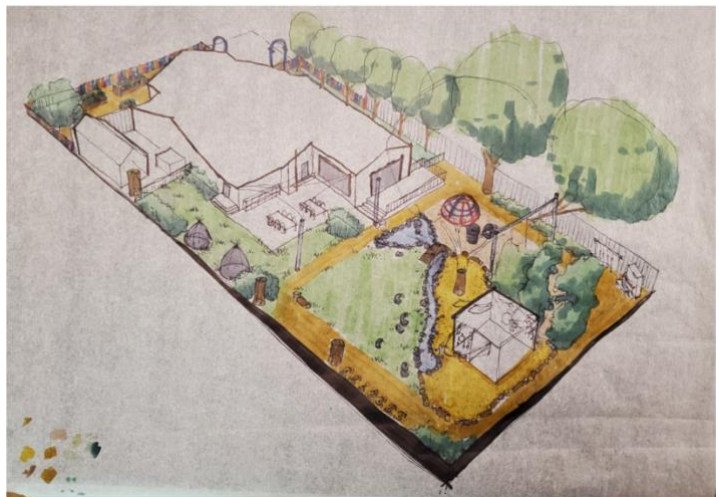
Current:
